We are sustainable.

- We avoid unnecessary consumption of water and light and consume 100% renewable energy.
- Our heating and hot water energy comes from “clean energy” wood pellets.
- The charcoal that we use in the grill of the restaurant is obtained from wood that is burned in November.
- We subscribe to Zero Km food and some of the food comes from our garden.
- The sports facilities created have no energy consumption.
- We recycle, using the different containers we have for each type of waste.

Velux windows.

- They have a control with different channels to open/close the shutter.
- Do not disable the rain sensor, it detects rain and prevents the window from remaining open.
- Do not open the window manually, as the rain sensor would be deactivated.



Room key card.

- It opens the entrance door to the park and the fence to access to the hotel and cottages.
- It also allows access to the hotel or exit from the side door of the hotel (the one next to the pool terrace), with direct access to the first floor, and/or the main entrance of the hotel.



Rubbish, household utensiles and accessories.

- If you need to replace the rubbish bag or an additional household utensiles, please call reception.



Heating.

- In order to regulate the temperature, the access card/ the room key card must be inserted into the entrance electronic lock.



Insects and small animals.

- During summer and autumn it is advisable to always keep the doors closed to prevent flies (always abundant where there is cattle).
- Pest control is carried out in all cottages but in a rural area some small animals can get in. Do not hesitate to call us to help.



Laundry.

- We have a laundry area with a washing machine and dryer. Ask for information at reception, and they will provide you with machine soap. The service incurs an extra charge of €3. Self-service.
- Linen is changed every three days. If you want or need to change your bed linen, it costs €15.

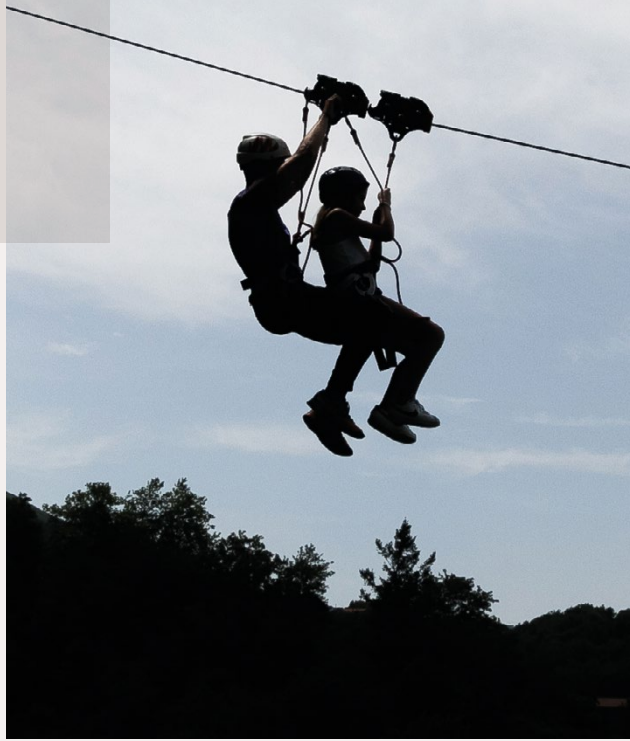

Adventure route

Duration: 40'

Pleasant walk through the forest, which includes crossing the Tibetan bridge.

Scenic route

Duration: 1h30'

A longer walk to visit different corners and views of the park. Along the route you can visit the interpretative centre, the limekiln (calera), the charcoal museum, etc

Sensory tour I & II

Duration: 60-90'

There are 2 parts. In the first, barefoot you will feel different textures of Nature, in the second part, you can develop your imagination with touch and finally, in the third and last part, with a blindfold, you will develop a sense of touch playing with Nature.

Mythological route

Duration: 60'

Discover the Basque mythological characters as a gymkhana.

Nature tour

Duration: 60'

A tour to get to know the fauna and the flora of IrriSarri Land. It joins the Mythological tour.

Looking for Baxi

Duration: 60 to 90'

Find the clues, get the numbers and decipher the message with which you should go to reception.

SURROUNDINGS



IrriSarri Land located in the north of Navarre has the following points of interest a few kilometers from the Park:

BORTZIRIAK:

Frain viewpoint - Mirador de Frain: (at 4km) One of the best views of the town of Igantzi.

Juan Xar Nature Reserve - Reserva Natural de San Juan Xar: (at 1,6km) Popular belief attributes healing powers to the water flowing from this point. Located on the climb to the Park

Ettxalar: (at 12km) Recipient of the National Tourism Award for the beautification and improvement of spanish villages. Its church and four ancient bridges are exceptional.

Lesaka: (at 8km) Beautiful village in the Valley through which the Bidasoa Greenway passes (Elizondo-Behobia Route).

Bera: (at 13,5km) Capital and largest town of the Valley. The neighborhood of Ibardin is located there and it's an important commercial spot.

Putzubeltz Waterfall: (Arantza) (13km)

MALERREKA:

Elgorriaga Spa resort - Balneario de Elgorriaga: (at 20km) SPA resort located 21km from the Park. (more information at reception).

Jauregia Palace: (at 21km) Monument located in Donamaria, village of the valley.

Water route: Easy route of 8km by foot or by mountain bike. It links the towns of Doneztebe-Elgorriaga-Ituren and Zubieta

BERTIZARANA:

Señorío de Bertiz Natural Park: (at 23km) Natural Park declared as a special conservation area with an area of 2,052 hectares.

BRIDGE OF ERREPARATZEA IN OIEREGI:

(21 km). It's one of the most beautiful bridges across the Bidasoa River.

ELIZONDO - BAZTAN:

Xorroxin Waterfall - Cascada de Xorroxin: (at 32 km) Spectacular waterfall located 2.5km from the town of Erratzu, which is accessible on foot by a signposted path.

Baztan viewpoint - Mirador del Baztán: (at 32km) On the road linking the villages of Irurita and Ziga.

ELIZONDO:

(32km) The capital of the Valley and where most of the services are located.

SURROUNDINGS

URDAZUBI:

URDAZUBI CAVES: and Trikuharri park (animals).

ZUGARRAMURDI:

CAVES OF ZUGARRAMURDI: (30 km) near the border with France is Zugarramurdi, the village of the witches. It's cave, 400 meters from Zugarramurdi, can be visited until sunset.

MUSEUM OF WITCHES: It is located in the same town.

FRENCH BASQUE COUNTRY (IPARRALDE):

HENDAIA (at 26km) - SAN JUAN DE LUZ (at 35km): Two beautiful villages in the French Aquitaine area, which are joined by a beautiful route (the corniche), an 8 km excursion that allows you to enjoy this cornice and admire the small bays and islands of the Basque-French coast.

BIARRITZ: (at 51km) Known for its famous beaches, therapeutic waters, surfing scene and sophisticated shops, as well as for its wonderful sunsets

CABLE CAR LARUN: (Sara)

AINHOA: Visit Sara and Ainhoa

GIPUZKOA:

IRUN: (at 26km) Is the closest city to the Park, full of shops, entertainment and nightlife.

HONDARRIBIA: (at 30km) Small fishing town where you can visit its famous Faro de Higer, the emblematic old town or its beach. With an extraordinary atmosphere during summer.

DONOSTIA/SAN SEBASTIAN: (at 46km): La Concha beach invites you for a pleasant stroll along its shores. The elegance of its bay, framed by Mount Igeldo and the island of Santa Clara. The city has two other beautiful urban beaches: La Zurriola beach and Ondarreta beach.

ZARAUTZ: (at 62,5km): Is a tourist village located in the center of the coast of the province and historical territories of Gipuzkoa, especially known by the surf world. Its beach is the largest in the Basque Country and one of the longest in Cantabria.

IrriSarri Land apart from the Park, offers practical information about the services around the area.
